FORMER HILLSBORO MAYOR CHAIRS CAMPAIGN

Shirley Huffman, popular Mayor of Hillsboro for eight years, retired last Fall, but she has not vanished from the public eye at all. She stays involved in a variety of organizations, including Washington County Community Action Organization (WCCAO), where she serves as the Board Chair and the Chair of their Capital Campaign. The Campaign is raising \$1.3 million to build a Multi-Service Center for the agency, which will house programs from five different sites, improve the non-profit agency's effectiveness and save \$100,000 a year in overhead costs. The savings in overhead is earmarked for enhanced family development services for low income families.

Huffman is joined on the Campaign's Steering Committee by an impressive group of community leaders, including Gary Conkling of Conkling, Fiskum & McCormick, and Bob Colfelt, Vice President and Manager at U.S. Bank. Also on board are Carol Clark, Executive Director of the Washington County Visitors Association; Linda Davis from Professional Corp; Sandra Miller, Personnel Director at the City of Beaverton; Sherry Robinson, Dean of Students at PCC Rock Creek and the agency's immediate past Chair; Senator Bob Shoemaker; Bob Wayt, Public Affairs Manager at GTE Northwest; and Russell L. Wilkinson, a CPA in Hillsboro who serves on WCCAO's Board and the Board of the Hillsboro Chamber.

The Steering Committee will oversee the Campaign through its culmination in early 1994. The agency hopes to break ground on their new facility in March 1994 and be moved in by January 1995.
