

**Articles of Incorporation**  
**Amended August 16, 1995**

**Community Action Organization**  
**Washington County, Oregon**

ARTICLE I

The *name* of this corporation is the Community Action Organization, and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

The general *purpose* of the Community Action Organization is to increase the availability of those community services and resources needed to promote the well-being and self-sufficiency of economically disadvantaged residents of Washington County, while striving to break the cycle of poverty.

ARTICLE III

The organization is a Public Benefit Corporation, *governed* by a tri-partied Board of Directors with equal representation from the public, private and low-income sectors of the community.

ARTICLE IV

The *address* of the registered office of the corporation is 1001 S.W. Baseline, Hillsboro, Oregon 97123, and the name of its registered agent is Jerralynn C. Ness.

ARTICLE V

Upon *dissolution* of the corporation, notice shall be given to the Attorney General. Assets will not be transferred until the Attorney General consents in writing or indicates that no action will be taken with respect to the transfer.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed in accordance with all applicable laws and a plan of distribution adopted by the Board. All liabilities and obligations of the corporation shall first be paid, satisfied, or discharged, or adequate provision shall be made therefor, and assets held by the corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution of final liquidation, shall be returned, transferred or conveyed in accordance with such requirements.
