The object of this meeting is to consult about the division of the Circuit. Bro. Tongue offered the following resolution. Resolved on more mature deliberation and fresh consultation with our Brethren and Sisters in the Church we believe it would not be desirable to follow the direction of the resolution of the last Quarterly Conference by dividing this Circuit. And after a full consultation a vote was taken with three for, and five against its passage

Subject of Finance were then called up and a deficiency reported in the charge of \$70.12 which was secured by reliable pledges making the years account square viz.
Bro. Hoberg \$712. & Bro Roberts \$80. Total \$792.
