Benefits of Family Child Care

- Providers may work with families to meet the needs of various employment schedules.
- Family child care may offer rates lower than center-based child care.
- There is generally one provider, which encourages strong bonds between provider and child.
- Family child care allows for a range of different ages, so siblings can be together within a home atmosphere.

Network of Family Child Care

The Employer Supported Network is comprised of carefully selected licensed Family Child Care providers. The Network supports families by matching specific child care needs with family child care providers.

Providers within the network have met specific standards and are committed to continuing their education in early childhood care and education. In support, the network provides access to professional development programs that focus on improving quality of family child care services through training, education, coaching, and networking.

The Network Coordinator delivers ongoing support and mentoring to each provider.



The Family Child Care Network Provides

- Access to a group of professional family child care providers.
- A Network Coordinator to provide direct assistance in matching family needs with specific provider services.
- Provider support through the Network Coordinator. The Coordinator creates professional development plans, conducts home visits and provides resources for business related and educational activities.
