Of the Sunday Schools under the auspices of our Church within the bounds of the Circuit all have suspended until Spring but two, one of which meets at Hillsboro and the other at Corniculus

The former is under the Superintendence of Bro. J. H. Tongue & the latter, since my arrival, owing to the sickness of Col. J. R. Corkeilus, the Superintendent has been conducted by Bro. J. R. Spence.

Both appear to be in a healthy and prosperous condition. That at Hillsboro numbers 75 scholars with an average att. of 55. Number of officers 4; Teachers 9.

The school at Corniculus numbers 100 with an average attendance of 50. Teachers 5. Officers 2.

I have preached 16 times, conducted 11 class and 6 prayer meetings, and made 70 pastoral calls.
