The SAFAH Program

The SAFAH Program of Community Action Organization and Shelter/DVRC helps families achieve self-sufficiency.

Family Advocates help families to:

- define goals, identify resources and take action
- increase income and maintain housing
- identify and remedy potential barriers to stable housing
- access programs and services



To be eligible for SAFAH you must:

- Be a family with children
- Be willing to participate in case management
- Be willing to sign a contract and agree to participate in the program for up to two years

All services are free and available throughout Washington County.
Family Advocates are based in Hillsboro and Tigard.
