I wish you all success.

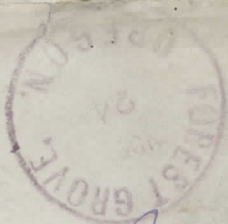
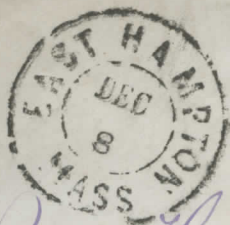
in your lectures. At the same time your resolution not to make the giving of your lectures a "Sine qua non" I think is a good one.
