I saw Pa as I came along  
Was tolerably well. Was up  
Town yesterday and got Ma  
Had been down to Mrs Hawthorn's  
this morning. Ma sent him down  
to see her about putting up some  
string beans as she was going to  
put some up today.

Pa complained of being cold,  
Quite pleasant this morn. clouds  
breaking up and will be a sun  
again this PM. I am glad you are  
by the sea. I know it will do  
you good.
