CCR&R supports providers with training and technical assistance, on-site literacy training, and business development; and provides Oregon employers with resources so they can help their employees with child care.

## Provider Resources—

Providers access our services for skill development and training, technical assistance, education, business assistance, and training on child care subsidy programs. CCR&R is the local expert in connecting providers to a comprehensive range of childhood care and education resources.

## Financial Assistance—

Employment Related Day Care is a child care financial assistance program. If a parent/family meets the household and general income requirements, they may be eligible for this assistance. Contact us to learn more.

## The Learning Circle—

The Learning Circle (TLC) is a literacy-based training program that provides training in the providers environment. The TLC program designed to stimulate the love of reading among English and Spanish speaking children of all ages. TLC mobile trainers model stimulating story times and related activities with the children in each provider's care.
