

ALTERNATE ENERGY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION:

- Description: The Commission is composed of nine members. There are six supporting task forces in Solar, Wind, Geothermal, Hydro, Agriculture and Forest Residues and Gasohol. One member from each of the task forces is on the Commission. In all, there are 81 persons involved on the Commission and task forces.
- Goal: To prepare and present a comprehensive alternate energy resources plan for Oregon -- to recommend state policy and to guide development of these resources to help meet Oregon's growing energy demands.
- Specific Tasks: Recommend specific legislation, programs, and policies to the Governor and Legislature for the coordinated development of alternate energy resources to meet Oregon's growing energy demands.
- Develop realistic estimates of how much and when energy would be available from these resources should the Commission recommendations be adopted. This assessment will include documentation of the current status of renewable resources in the State and consideration of the social, economic, institutional and ethical issues involved.
- Workplan: The Commission Report is due to the Governor by September, 1980. A detailed workplan follows.
