SUBJECT: Governor's Meeting with McFarlane

The private meeting with Robert C. "Bud" McFarlane was confirmed today. McFarlane will meet with the Governor in the Governor's Hyatt Suite at 2:30 p.m., Wednesday, August 22. Only Mr. McFarlane will be attending.

Because we do not yet have the Governor's room number, please arrange for McFarlane to be met at the reception desk and ushered to the Governor's room -- or have McFarlane cleared at the desk to be directed to the Governor's room.

McFarlane will be traveling with his private secretary, Wilma Hall, who will be your contact point for McFarlane. McFarlane will only be in Texas on Wednesday, but will be headquartered at The Anatole (room unknown). Both names -- Miles and Holbrook -- have been provided to McFarlane as contact points for the Governor.

## Background:

McFarlane's title is Assistant to the President. He is the head of the National Security Council and is a direct advisor to the President for foreign affairs.

The National Security Council is comprised of the President, Vice President, Secretary of State, Chief of Department of Defense, Chief of the CIA and the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff.

The CIA is also requesting a debriefing of Governor. Their Portland representative, Jim Assuras, admits they handled the situation badly from the beginning. He will wait to debrief Governor upon Governor's return to Oregon.
