We are the largest private University in Korea and have grown to include 11 colleges, 6 graduate schools and a second campus 20 miles from the city of Seoul. I am enclosing under separate cover a University Bulletin, which will help to explain more about our University.

I have been in correspondance with Dr. Joseph Hah, who is teaching at Lewis and Clark University in Portland. He has informed me that you are planning to visit Korea later in the year and that you have a great interest in helping to improve the already close relations between the United States and the Republic of Korea.
