Report of Committee appointed at 2d. Quarterly meeting consisting of J. W. Miller to confer with the Preacher in Charge of the East Tuleatin Circuit with reference to adjusting the boundary lines of circuits so as to make it practicable to divide Hillsboro Circuit, was called for and report was addressed to a division

The Chair advised the members of the conference interested in the division to lay the matter before the Bishop of the O. A. Conference and advise with him concerning the matter. The Presiding Bishop Jesse S. Beck preached at several places in the circuit at which time brethren advised with him about dividing the circuit in order to have regular preaching each sabbath at Forest Grove if possible and at the twenty third session of the Oregon Annual Conference a division of Hillsboro Circuit was effected and the new division takes the name of "Forest Grove Circuit."
